PRECIS OF REPORT.

Two Sergeants and nine constables R.I.B. were investigating an alleged larceny in Altamount Street Westport. Passing under the Railway Bridge the Patrol was extended at intervals of 15 yards. The Bridge is 20 feet over the street and the parapets are of solid iron 5 feet high. The attackers took up position behind the parapets from which they flung at least 4 bombs at the Patrol. The Patrol replied with rifle fire and bombs and dispersed the attackers. 3 constables were seriously wounded and 3 were slightly wounded. It is not known whether the raiders suffered any damage.
